





Dear children! “ May this time be for you a time of prayer, so that the Holy Spirit, through prayer, may descend upon you and give you conversion. Open your hearts and read the Sacred Scripture, that through the testimonies you also may be closer to God. Above everything, little children, seek God and the things of God and leave earthly ones to the earth, because Satan is attracting you to the dust and sin. You are called to holiness and created for Heaven; therefore, seek Heaven and the things of Heaven. Thank you for having responded to my call.”

Dear Brothers and Sisters of Medjugorje North East and beyond, Mary Queen and Mother of Peace is our Heavenly Mother and our teacher too. In the school of Prayer that is called 'Medjugorje', a school of love, Mary as Mother of the Church, teaches us how to receive the divine life of her Son, and calls us to the Gospel message of conversion and repentance.

Act of the Apostle 1: 12-14 we read of the situation of the early believers after Our Lord's Ascension into heaven. Following the names of the twelve apostles we read, *“All these joined in continuous prayer, together with several women, including Mary the Mother of Jesus.”*

Mary is the woman of Prayer and Adoration who gathers the first believers together around her in the upper room, and there they are joined in 'continuous' prayer. Before everything else, the Church in it's

very infancy recognises that it's path forward is determined in Prayer. So too, for all of us in the school of Our Lady, are called by her to enter more fully into the divine life of her Son.

“May this time be for you a time of Prayer.” Finding time for Prayer is not a problem of time, but of love. if we only Pray when time allows then we may not pray at all. Mary teaches us how to weave into our days the very rhythm of prayer, for Prayer is the key to unlocking all the graces from the heart of Jesus. In the early days of the apparitions Our Lady said, *“Dear Children, you want to receive graces, but without praying. I desire that you begin to work on your hearts like a farmer ploughing the earth.”* (1987)

Let us make the decision for prayer out of love, because in last month's message Our Lady told us that only in prayer can we receive the promised gift of the Holy Spirit.

"So that the Holy Spirit, through Prayer, may descend on you and give you conversion."


Let us remember the importance of devotion to the Holy Spirit. Our calling upon the Spirit is fundamental to our Spiritual growth. I would recommend the regular praying of the Veni Creator Spiritus, or the Sequence to the Holy Spirit, in this time of Grace. For three months now, Mary has reminded us of the importance of the Holy Spirit.

Mary then calls us to open the Holy Scriptures, "**The testimonies**" will draw us closer to God. Let us take the Holy Scriptures and reverence them. The Bible contains Gods own Word. With a power to heal and to inspire. If we start holding the Bible in our hands and reverencing it, Jesus will put a love for his word in your heart. He will also Bless you and speak to you. Trace over yourself the three crosses as at Mass, when hear the Gospels proclaimed, and ask the Lord to fill your mind, words and heart with the saving power of his word. Place the Scriptures in a visible place in your home, and as Mary says, "**The Testimonies will lead you closer to God.**"

"Above everything seek God and the things of God"

Dear Brothers and Sisters how easily distracted we become and lose sight of our true priorities. "Above all else" says Our Lady, she wants us to recognise what is truly important in our lives, that is seeking God. To seek him in Holy Scripture, to seek him in Holy Mass, in Holy Confession, these are the things that should be "Above all else" Let us search for him, call on him, seek him

out, and make the Sacrifice to encounter him in prayer. May we know earthly desires, Television, internet, endless socialising, shopping, etc, and recognise the moment to choose the greater good of Prayer and spiritual reflection. "**Leave earthly ones to the earth.**" None of us wants to be in the dust of the earth and in sin, so Mary points our way ahead Our dignity as Children of God is far greater, far more beautiful. For we are called to holiness and are created for heaven.



Dear Friends, Mary calls us once again to have trust in her and to start again, because our time is growing short. Take time for holy Scripture, to Confess, to go to Holy Mass. We should not forget that these are Mary's times, and that she comes to us so that we may stay with her and find our way to Heaven.

The Anniversary of the solemn blessing of Medjugorje parish church

This year we are remembering 49 years since the church of St. James was built and solemnly blessed. After the parish was founded in 1892, the first parish church, very spacious and beautiful for the circumstances back then, was soon completed in 1897. Due to the unstable ground on which it was built, the walls began to crack and the building began to sink, so immediately after the World War I, parishioners began to think about the construction of the new church. The works were initiated in 1934, and were completed on January 19, 1969, when this church was blessed. The church of St. James today is the centre of sacramental and prayer life not just of the parishioners, rather of pilgrims from all over the world.

Dear Children of Medjugorje,
praise be to Jesus and Mary!

1. On January 2, 2018, Mirjana received her monthly apparition at the Blue Cross, in the presence of all those who came to entrust the New Year to the Heart of Mary.

After the apparition, she conveyed the message that Mary addresses to all of us: (See page 4)

2. A Beautiful Christmas Present!

At a Christmas gathering with my Community, I drew from a basket the name of a saint, my companion for the year 2018, as I hope you all do too. Well, to my great surprise, I found that this companion was actually a "legion"! What did the paper say? I read: "The Guardian Angels". Not just my own Guardian Angel (who is very used to protecting me), but all the Guardian Angels! I do not know what to expect in this coming year, but if such a crowd of heavenly friends chose me, then they have their reasons.



Do you know that a single Guardian

Angel, even the smallest of all, is more powerful than all the demons of hell put together? This is understandable, because a Guardian Angel has God with him, and the demons do not. The task that I am gifted with is a delight for me: "To make the Guardian Angels known". So let's start right here!

As a child, my parents taught me to speak with my Angel and confide in him to be guided and protected. As a little girl, I gave him a name, Raphael, just to make my relationship with him easier. This name was not a revelation, I chose it thinking that he would be happy to bear the name of an Archangel! I thank my parents for having been able to tell me about angels, because I have developed a great and simple friendship with him, without any big mystical experiences. The "little way" of St. Therese of the Child Jesus, without any extraordinary manifestations, is the safest path for me...

One event struck me considerably when I lived in Nazareth. Sylvie, one of the sisters in my Community, came from Protestantism and was still struggling to pray to the saints and angels. Whenever I shared my stories with my Guardian Angel during meals, how he had protected me or how he had helped me in a difficult times, this sister would murmur to herself that this was all hokey. But because these events were real, she decided in secret to test it all herself, just to get to the bottom of this business.



One morning, she prayed this prayer: "Raphael, if we really have to pray to the angels and take them on as friends, give me a sign. I am going to tell you something that you will have to pass on to Sr. Emmanuel. If I see that she picks up the message, you will have won, and I will pray to the angels." The morning went by, and for lunch, I went home and told the sisters right away: "Guess what the Lord gave me to understand today!" And I quoted the message that Sylvie had given to my Guardian Angel, verbatim. At the time, she didn't tell me anything as she first had to recover from the shock. But eventually, she became one of the greatest "fans" of the Guardian Angels!

3. Is Your Angel Unemployed?

We are living way below our means. Yes, I said well below! We are suffering from loneliness, misunderstandings, powerlessness in communicating with our loved ones, we are unclear as to which direction to take... and we don't turn to the celestial friends that God posted at our side! And yet, the more we ask of them, the more they help us. They are given the responsibility of placing us on, or bringing us back to, the path of God, leading us to choose God's will instead of seeking to please people.

Every Guardian Angel knows God's special plan for his protégé. Angels are so infinitely precious to us when we live with them in the invisible realm!

Many parents complain about not being listened to by their children, because they prefer to listen to friends of their own age and conform to their way of life. But are these parents forgetting that their child too has an Angel eager to keep him or her emotionally and physically? When there is no more dialogue or when it becomes too difficult, angels help us out divinely. They suggest to the conscience of their protégé the things that please God. And their way of suggesting is so humble and subtle that their charge believes that these are his own thoughts, and therefore acts according to what was suggested to him. Of course this is not automatic, but with a confident prayer to the Angels, we obtain surprising results. Padre Pio was a great friend of angels, to such a degree that his angels would answer his overabundant mail for him! How could he write so many letters when he spent all his time in the confessional?!



From the beginning of the apparitions, the Blessed Mother asked

every member of the prayer group to make friends with his Guardian Angel and write him a letter. She would collect these letters during the apparition on the next day. They didn't really know how to do this, but they wrote the letter and placed it at the feet of the Mother of God the next day. As a result, they developed a good relationship with the Angels! This was very enriching for them, especially under the Communist oppression where any protection was a Godsend. Remember that, in case of possible new oppressions today!

4. That was close!

Martha is a young girl who is very connected to Medjugorje. Here is what she told us:

"I live in Normandy and I had just turned 22. I successfully passed my exam as a French teacher and above all I had experienced a strong conversion to the Catholic faith. In short, I was living a happy and very promising year! One evening, after I had spent a wonderful weekend with friends, I was getting ready to go home. I had 3 hours driving ahead of me, and it was already after midnight! My friends strongly advised me not to leave until the next morning. But for me, that was out of the question because I was working the next day.

So I set off, and after a quarter of an hour, I started feeling sleepy. To get home faster, I started speeding at 93 mph (150 km/hr) for about an hour on the highway when I fell asleep at the wheel. Then something truly extraordinary happened. In the space of a few split seconds, I had a vision

of a very bright Angel, and in my heart I knew that it was my Guardian Angel.

He was very big, as if to tell me that he was protecting me and his light was so intense that it woke me up suddenly! I was racing straight for a security railing at 93mph! I had just enough time to swerve to avoid it and get back on the road! That was close... a split second! God is good.



Because of my carelessness, my life could have ended there, at the age of 22, all bloody on the side of the road! But God took pity on me and allowed my Guardian Angel to save me. As Psalm 91 says: "For he hath given his angels charge over thee; to keep thee in all thy ways." I give thanks to God for having protected me and for giving me a Guardian Angel who watches over me. Don't forget that you too have a Guardian Angel who watches over you and your loved ones!"

Here is a simple prayer you could say to your Angel:

"Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom God's love commits me here, ever this day be at my side, to light and guard, to rule and guide. Amen"

Vatican Committee Declares Medjugorje Apparitions as Real and of "Supernatural Origin"

The commission established by Pope Benedict XVI to study the apparitions of Mary at Medjugorje, Bosnia-Herzegovina, has voted overwhelmingly to recognise as supernatural the first seven appearances of Mary in 1981. The 17-man commission on Medjugorje was established by Benedict XVI in 2010, and was chaired by Cardinal Camillo Ruini.

Despite the previous lack of formal recognition by the Vatican, pilgrims have flocked to Medjugorje. Since the apparitions began in 1981, an estimated more than 40 million people from all over the world have visited Medjugorje. Thousands of healings and deep conversions have been reported. Pilgrims continue to flock to this very day.

Understanding the Commission's Report

The Church has a very strict and precise terminology for judging alleged apparitions of Our Lady. According to the norms of the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith, alleged apparitions are classified in one of three categories:

- Constat de supernaturalitate – It is certain that the events are of supernatural origin.
- Constat de non supernaturalitate – It is certain that the events are not of supernatural origin.

- Non-constat de supernaturalitate – It is not certain that the events are of supernatural origin.

The official ruling of the commission is as follows:

- The first seven apparitions, between the period June 24-July 3, 1981, are declared "Constat de supernaturalitate": it is certain that the events are of supernatural origin
- The subsequent apparitions (those that occurred after July 3, 1981) are declared "non-constant de supernaturalitate", which means that it is not certain that the events are of supernatural origin.

While the commission declared the first seven apparitions that occurred between June 24 to July 3, 1981 as worthy of belief and of a supernatural nature, the commission decided to suspend judgement on the thousands of subsequent apparitions that have continued to happen, and still continue up to the present day. This does not mean that the subsequent apparitions after 1981 are "disapproved" or discredited in any way. It only means that the commission members have deemed that it was not possible to make a judgement on the subsequent apparitions.

Archbishop Hoser Gives Press Conference in Medjugorje

April 7, 2017

On April 5, 2017, the Special Envoy to Medjugorje, Archbishop Henryk Hoser, gave a lengthy press conference in Medjugorje. Giving compassionate, candid, and generous remarks, Hoser expressed an open heart to the events in Medjugorje.

Here is Archbishop Hoser's opening remarks at the press conference:

Medjugorje is known in the whole world. And we should know that pilgrims are coming from about 80 countries from all over the world.

Every year 2 ½ million pilgrims come here. discovering something extraordinary.

The first thing is the atmosphere, it is the atmosphere of peace and reconciliation. It is an atmosphere of inner peace, of peace of the heart. Also what they discover is a huge space for profound religion and spirituality. They discover or rediscover what it means in their lives to have something sacred, something holy. In Medjugorje they encounter sacred time and sacred space. That sacredness means something that is reserved for something divine.

Usually it is said that Medjugorje is a place where we honor Our Lady, and that is the truth. But if we look at it in a deeper way, we see that it is actually Christocentric, completely turned towards Christ. Christ-life! Worshiping. For instance, at the center is the celebration of the Holy Eucharist, the transmission of the Word of God, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament where one discovers the real presence of Jesus Christ in His divinity and in His

humanity. Some also discover the prayer of the Rosary, that is meditative prayer on the mysteries of our faith. And when they pray the Way of the Cross, they enter into the Paschal mystery which is the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ.

I would like to conclude with the reality of Holy Confession, the Sacrament of Reconciliation, the personal and the personalized sacrament. From the religious perspective, Medjugorje is very fertile ground.

Archbishop Hoser resigns

December 2017

The papal envoy appointed by Pope Francis to review the pastoral needs of Medjugorje has resigned as bishop of Poland's Warszawa-Praga diocese.

Archbishop Henryk Hoser made headlines when he praised Medjugorje and revealed that official pilgrimages were now allowed by the Vatican.

Some have speculated that Hoser will be appointed to oversee Medjugorje in a pastoral role, which could explain his resignation. He also recently turned 75 years old, the age when Catholic bishops are supposed to resign from pastoral care. Hoser's 75th birthday was November 27th, incidentally the feast of the Miraculous Medal which also involves apparitions of the Virgin Mary.

The news of Hoser's resignation was posted in the Vatican bulletin and reads as follows:

Resignation and succession of bishop of Warszawa-Praga, Poland

The Holy Father Francis has accepted the resignation from the pastoral care of the diocese of Warszawa-Praga, Poland, presented by H.E. Msgr. Henryk Hoser, S.A.C.

He is succeeded by H.E. Msgr. Romuald Kamiński, currently coadjutor bishop.

OUR LADY OF LOURDES

The Healing waters of Lourdes continue to flow

(Briega McKenna May 1981 an insight into Medjugorje) "And from behind him on the altar there were streams of water, like rivers flowing, and the young people were cupping it and drinking it, and after they would drink it they would go out and bring others in."

Throughout the shrines of the world Our Lady's message is the same, from Lourdes 1858 to Medjugorje 1981 until Present

Our Lady's message of Love is for mankind to turn back to God

For Catholics, Lourdes is one of the world's beloved Shrine. Nestled in a valley in the south-western part of the Hautes-Pyrenees France. it is the scene of pilgrims gathering from all over the world.

On February 11, 1858, the Virgin revealed herself to a poor shepherd girl, Bernadette Soubirous born January 7, 1844. Eighteen such apparitions were reported.

At the Grotto of Massabielle the Virgin Mary appeared 18 times to Bernadette between February 11 and July 16, 1858.

She asked for a chapel to be built on the site of the apparitions and when asked who she was, she replied: "*I am the Immaculate Conception.*"

Our Lady asked Bernadette to wash her face at the fountain but there was no fountain, '*Go and drink at the spring and wash there*' so Bernadette dug a hole in the ground, and with muddy water washed her face while people ridiculed her, however from there sprang the famous fountain of

water that has healing attributes. Many sick people have bathed themselves in that water and there have been at least 64 reported miraculous healings.

At the back of the Grotto, is the Miraculous Spring that spouted on February 25, 1858, during the ninth apparition. The water from this spring is collected in several reservoirs, from which you can drink.

Millions of people from all over the world go to Lourdes in the hope of obtaining help from the generous Mother of God.

Bernadette became a nun. She died in 1879 aged 35. She was beatified in 1925 and Canonized in 1933. Her body remains incorrupt




