



Dear Brothers and Sisters ofMedjugorje North East and beyond, Since the very first appearances of Our Lady Oueen of Peace in Medjugorje, in 1981. Mary has always emphasised time and again, the reason for her coming. To remind us that God exists, and that we can encounter him in Prayer. All of the messages invite us to Pray, to pray often, and to learn to pray with and from the heart. that is to **pray** with love. Our Lady wants to bless all people with a new and profound spirit of prayer. Because the world and the Church need this new breath of So, our decision to pray should be made with love, because once we have made this first step we have already begun what Mary is asking of us. "I am calling you to be with me in prayer." - so begins this month's message.

It is always dangerous if we let our prayers depend on feelings or desires, then we may hardly pray at all. Mary, asks that we "decide for God" and this decision begins with the gift of our time in prayer, then everything

in us that should grow, will grow when we are close to the Lord in prayer. One of the reasons why there is so much unbelief today, and lukewarmness in the faith, and a great lack of peace in many hearts is because we are not praying enough. Prayer, reawakens Apostolic zeal and fervour in our love for the Lord.

Because we should not underestimate the times we are living in, Mary says, "When darkness is fighting against the light" we are reminded of the spiritual battle that the world and every believer is engaged in. This is, I sense, a wakeup call for all of us who have heard the call of the Queen of Peace and try to live Our Lady's messages.

The situation is really serious, but Mary is the woman of Faith and Hope who shows us the way to the light, and who points us away from the powers of darkness to the splendour of the light of truth. Let us not forget she is the woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet and

with the crown of stars around her head. She will be victorious, but has always told us she needs our prayers and Faith.

Following on from last month's message Our Lady points us to faith in the sacraments of the Church.

"Confess and begin a new life of Grace, be proud that you are baptised." On Calvary when Our Lord's side was pierced, "there came out blood and water," (John:19:34) The gift of the Holy Spirit, of God's mercy and new life, Confession and Baptism. This is the gift of Divine Mercy, and Mary asks us to be 'proud of our Baptism and grateful'.

Thank Jesus often for the day of your baptism, and the sacrament of Reconciliation.

Dear Friends in this Easter season, when Mary alerts us to the powers of darkness and deception let us make a clear decision for God, for Prayer and Faith in Jesus Christ. A decision for God in these days means a decision for Truth, Goodness, Love and Mercy. A decision for life.

"Dear children! great are the works that the Heavenly Father has done in me, as He does in all those who love Him tenderly and who faithfully and devoutly serve Him. My children, the Heavenly Father loves you, and it is through His love that I am here with you. He is speaking to you. Why do you not desire to see the signs? Everything is easier alongside Him. Also, pain lived with Him is easier because faith exists. Faith helps in the pain, and pain without faith leads to despair. Pain lived and offered to God raises up. Did my Son not redeem the world through His painful sacrifice? As His mother I was

with Him in the pain and suffering, as I am with all of you. My children, I am with you in life, in suffering, in pain, in joy and in love. Therefore, have hope. It is hope that makes you comprehend that life is there. My children, I am speaking to you, my voice is speaking to your soul, my heart is speaking to your heart. Oh, apostles of my love, how much my motherly heart loves you. How many things I desire to teach you. How my motherly heart desires that you be complete, and you can be complete only when your soul, body and love are united within you. I implore you as my children, pray much for the Church and her servants - your shepherds; that the Church may be such as my Son desires - clear as spring water and full of love. Thank you."

Medjugorje, March 18, 2018 Month of St. Joseph

Dear Children of Medjugorje, praise be to Jesus and Mary!

1. On March 2, 2018 Mirjana received her monthly apparition in her home, in the presence of a small crowd. After the apparition, she shared the message, which Our Lady gives to all of us: (see page 4)

2. St. Joseph in Sicily?

On March 19th, we celebrated the Solemnity of the great St Joseph. Many offered him a Novena or Thirty Day Prayer, even a entrusting him with their most urgent intentions. One of my dear sisters tells this story that illustrates the kindness of this his saint. his humor and effectiveness.

"I was in a house belonging to the community of the Beatitudes, in Pettineo, Sicily. This house was an old Franciscan convent, very cold and very humid. At that time, there were about 30 of us in the House and we lived in great and very severe poverty. There were neither small nor larger sources of income. We often had many guests who came to pray with us and who stayed for a meal.

I remember that one day, we had nothing to eat. Many of us were young and it was not easy for everyone to eat their fill. Our superiors always told us that Saint Joseph is the father of Providence, and they would tell us a lot of stories about people who had received his help. So we, the younger crowd, still full of zeal, said, "Let's make a shopping list with everything we need, and also add some things we'd like to have", and that's what we did. So in that list, there all sorts of things and there was something for evervone... even Nutella and so many other things that were not really useful. Trusting St Joseph blindly, we put that list behind his image, in the prayer corner in the kitchen.



Every day, we prayed to St. Joseph. We were completely taken by surprise when someone suddenly knocked at the door and left lots of bags! We couldn't

believe our eyes! We put all the bags on the big kitchen table. We dared not open them... and then someone exclaimed: "Take the shopping list!" It felt like a treasure hunt: one sister read the products on the list and the others looked inside the bags to see if they were in there. We were amazed, it was like a game of tombola! Nothing was missing! Well ... almost nothing!

I remember Piero's face, he just fell silent in sadness when the sister finished reading the list. Only one thing was missing, peppers! "No, that's not possible! Saint Joseph, should have remembered my peppers! No, that isn't fair!" While he expressed his criticism because there were no peppers, suddenly a familiar voice was heard on the stairs: it was Madame Inès, God rest her soul...

Ines was an elderly lady, a widow who lived alone in Pettineo and who often came to see us. Inés raised her voice on the staircase, she was annoyed by something. In the meantime, Piero was grumbling against St. Joseph in the kitchen, while Ines was expressing her irritation.

- 'What's wrong, Ines? Why are you angry?'
- 'Well nothing! I brought you some peppers in oil, and the jar opened in my bag!'

Poor thing! She did not immediately understand why her

purse stained with oil turned our home into a party!

No, St. Joseph had forgotten absolutely nothing! He just had his own plan: he wanted someone else to become an instrument of God's Providence, and that was Ines. He wanted us to no longer be doubters, he wanted us to be believers!"

St. Joseph did not have an easy time in his life! The torment of seeing Mary with child. the rejection of the people Bethlehem, the extreme poverty of the stable where Jesus was born. the flight to Egypt by night and the long stay as a political refugee there, without any regular work nor any income, losing Jesus at the age of 12 with those three days of terrible anguish... In short, this man was weathered by ordeals and humiliations, how could be not understand our troubles of today? As Mary said on March 2nd, "Near Him (Jesus), everything is easier. Suffering next to Him is easier because there is faith. Faith helps when you are in pain, and suffering without faith leads to despair. Suffering that is experienced and offered to God raises us up."

3. Two Cardinals on a mission!

My assistant and I just came back from 4 days in Riga (Latvia), a beautiful mission among very heart-warming people. On our way there, we met Cardinal

Schönborn who was on the same flight. He blessed our mission, then said a few words to me about talk with Pope Francis regarding Medjugorje. Actually, the Pope didn't say anything special. However, the Cardinal's personal opinion is the following: in the absence of an official position from Rome, he thinks that "the results of the Ruini Commission, which were touted by the Pope on May 13th, could be picked up as being the position of the Church." This sounds very positive to me. Still, let us pray more in confidence!



Just before leaving Riga, our small team was received by Cardinal Janis Pujats, retired, who suffered a great deal from the KGB during the Communist persecution, like all his faithful, before the collapse of the Soviet Union. But he managed to stay the course and avoid the labor camps thanks to him listening to the Holy Spirit. He had managed to create a secret printing press and to print thousands of prayer books. He doesn't live like a prince; he lives like a pauper, which moved us a

great deal. He has to walk up 3 floors with no elevator to get home, and he walked down those stairs to welcome us. He blessed the fruits of our mission. We felt the hand of God upon us, the blessing of a cardinal before the



mission and that of another cardinal at the end!

Thank you, your prayers served us in good stead! Please don't stop praying!

4. "Paul, Apostle of Christ"

The film with Jim Caviezel, "Paul, Apostle of Christ", will released on 28 March in movie theatres. Jim Caviezel, actor of "The Passion of the Christ", is announcing Mel Gibson's film. His message is quite Medjugorian (from 9.56 to 10.42) with Mary's 5 points. He also talks about Saint Maximilian Kolbe who said "Indifference is the greatest sin of the 21st century." He agrees with this. When the stars of this world become Christian, how powerful is that!

Before the vote, there will be 40 days of adoration in the little chapel at the top of the mountain called Croagh Patrick, where St. Patrick spent 40 days in prayer.



Jim Caviezel: If it wasn't for Medjugorje, I wouldn't have ever played in the movie "The Passion of the Christ"

Jim Caviezel became the world-famous actor with leading role in Mel Gibson's movie "Passion". Who is that actor that has so impressively

with become one ofJesus? character Personally, he claims that if it wasn't for Medjugorje, he wouldn't have ever even accepted that Namely, in role. Medjugorje he had experienced certain

dimension of faith that was unknown to him up to that point.

'My wife came to Medjugorje while I was in Ireland, shooting the movie "Monte Cristo".'

Also at the same time Ivan Dragicevic came to speak and give witness in Ireland:

'During the time of the apparition, I knelt close to him and I said in my heart: "Ok, here I am. I am ready. Do with me what you want." In the same moment I felt as something was fulfilling me. It was very simple, and yet unique. When I got up, tears were running down my cheeks and I started to cry with all of my heart.

Ivan told me: "Jim, man always finds time for what he loves. If somebody who doesn't have any time finds a girlfriend and falls in love with her, he will always find time for her. People don't have time for God because they do not love Him." And he continued: "God is inviting you to pray with the heart." I asked him: "How am I supposed to do that?" he said "By starting to pray",

After shooting was completed, and that was in Malta, I decided to go to Medjugorje.

Medjugorje reminded me of Bethlehem and I thought, as Jesus

was born in a small place, in the same way the Mother of God is appearing in one poor village in between hills. Those four days I spent in Medjugorje were my turning point. In the very beginning I

was still amazed at how much people in Medjugorje prayed. Everything reminded me of basketball camp, and I thought there you do not play one match a day, but always, constantly, anew. The same is in the school where you do not read just once a day, but always, repeatedly. In those first days in Medjugorje I felt inner unrest while I was praying, because I was not used to prayer that much, and I was asking God to help me. After four days the only thing I wanted to do was to pray. Whenever I prayed, I felt connected with God.

Thanks to Medjugorje I started to believe that Jesus was really present in the Eucharist, and that he forgives me my sins. Through Medjugorje I experienced how the Rosary is powerful prayer and what gift we have when we attend Holy Mass every day.

If it wasn't for Medjugorje I wouldn't have ever agreed to take the part, because it was in Medjugorje that my heart opened to prayer and to sacraments. If I wanted to play Jesus,

I knew I needed to be very close to him. Every day I went to confession and I attended Eucharistic Adoration. Mel Gibson was coming to Holy Mass as well with the condition that Holy Mass is in Latin.

'Paul the Apostle of Christ'

Jim Caviezel plays Luke (www.catholicnewsagentcy)

It has been more than a decade since Jim Caviezel played Jesus in the "Passion of the Christ." This spring, he'll play St. Luke in another major religious film, "Paul, the Apostle of Christ," opening in theatres on March 28.

Unlike the "Passion," Caviezel will not be the main actor in the film: James Faulkner, star of HBO's "Game of Thrones," will portray Paul.

"James Faulkner is to Paul as Christopher Reeve is to Superman. ... This guy was born to play Paul. When he was walking around, it was in his behaviour. You couldn't find someone else who organically nails it like this," Caviezel recently told USA Today.

The movie follows St. Paul in the last days of his life, facing Roman imprisonment for preaching Christianity while waiting execution under Emperor Nero. Luke, a physician, is able to visit his fellow Christian in jail.

Caviezel said the movie's theme centers on forgiveness and merciful love, a message relevant today, and he recalled a powerful scene in which Paul restrains Luke from calling for justice on the Roman oppressors.

"Forgiveness starts with not just love, but ardent love," Caviezel told USA Today. "It's really easy to love people who think like you think; it's very hard to treat someone with a polar opposite view with the same dignity and respect you would treat a friend. That's this movie's core message."

Since Caviezel played the role of

Christ, he has received offers for parts in other religious movies, but is picky about the movies that change scriptural stories.

It's like, "We want to change this, pull that out," said Caviezel. I'm like, 'This book has been around a lot longer than any of us in Hollywood.'

"I have the faith to believe it's still good for us now. That's one of the greatest things about 'Paul'. You don't realize it, but it's actually scriptural."

While the release of 'Paul' is still a month away, Caviezel is also excited about another movie, the sequel to "The Passion," again directed by Mel Gibson.

Caviezel has not disclosed the sequel's tentative schedule for the filming date but has hinted at some surprises in the retelling of Christ's resurrection.

"There are things that I cannot say that will shock the audience," he said. "But I'll tell you this much: The film Mel Gibson's going to do is going to be the biggest film in history. It's that good."

Mel Gibson has talked about the movie in the past. He has said it has taken time to develop a script that sheds a new light on Christ's resurrection without making it 'weird.'

"The resurrection. Big subject. We're trying to craft this in a way that's cinematically compelling and enlightening so that it shines new light, if possible."
