

He conquered death to give you life, eternal life. Therefore, little children, witness and be proud that you have resurrected in Him. Thank you for having responded to my call. ”

### Fr. Martin Morris's Reflection

Brothers and Sisters of Medjugorje North East and beyond,

In this month's message Our Lady Queen and Mother of Peace reminds us the sole reason for the existence of the Church, and what it means to be a Christian. Our Lady is the Mother of the Church and she focuses us on the essential message of Christianity in this reflection. It is the Easter proclamation of the Church, that Jesus Christ Crucified, is risen from the dead, and has forgiven our sins through His blood, and will come again in glory. (1: Corinthians. 15:1-4)

In AD56 St. Paul wrote to the believers in Corinth to remind them of this truth:

*"Christ died for our sins, He rose on the third day and He will come again."*

We would do well to reflect on this piece of Scripture regularly and to

commit it to memory, because it is the basic message of the Church. It is this central truth of the Church, it's the primary message, that Our Lady reminds us of in the Easter season. It is the same message proclaimed by the Apostles in the days following the Resurrection and Ascension of Christ. **“You Little children, be the Joy of the risen Jesus who died and resurrected for each of you. He conquered death to give you life, eternal life. Therefore, little children, witness and be proud that you have resurrected in him.”**

So many people feel that God is distant from them, so Our Lady asks us to be like the Apostles and be the Joy of the Risen Jesus. It is a personal assurance that each believer has received in the Cross and Resurrection of Our Lord. **“For each of you”** says the Mother of God.

When we have encountered this marvellous gift of salvation in Christ then we can be the joy of the Risen Jesus. Our friendship with the risen Jesus radiates the beautiful truth that He is with us and for us. *“Emmanuel, God for us and with us.”* This is the security of our lives, to know that Jesus Christ died for us and rose for us. True Christian joy has its source in the risen Lord Jesus, the central truth of the Church’s proclamation. This is why maybe so many pilgrims flock and gather around the statue of the Risen Christ in Medjugorje and find there, tenderness and healing for their souls.

Our Lady knows that many people in the world are living without real joy, and so she points us to the real treasure of the faith of the Church. This is real Joy, to know Christ Crucified and the power of his Resurrection. Our Lady is asking us to be the Apostles today and become **“the Joy of the risen Jesus who died and resurrected for all.”**

When we are in contact with the Risen Jesus, especially in the Holy Mass, then we have a deep inner grace that keeps the heart open to God, for ourselves and for others. This is why on so many times Our Lady has asked us to *“Celebrate Holy Mass with Faith, with the heart”* For a true sense of Joy comes from the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. When we go to Jesus with an open heart and place ourselves in His Risen and Glorified Presence then Joy and Strength comes to us.

We Christians are called to show Joy and Hope where there is sadness and disorder, to be Peace and

Reconciliation where there is **peacelessness**. To be the consolation of those who are discouraged.

May we often remember to pray before the cross of Christ, to shelter in His wounds, to take the crucifix in our hands, and to pray: *“Lord Jesus, thank you for dying for me, through the power of your holy cross, do not allow disorder and peacelessness to reign in me, but conquer my heart with your peace and grace. For by your wounds we are healed.”*

We must claim the victory that Christ won for us in his Cross and Resurrection, by praying the Holy Mass from the heart too.

Brothers and sisters, after the Resurrection of Jesus, we read in the Acts of the Apostles, *“With one heart all these joined in constant prayer with Mary the Mother of Jesus.”* ( Acts 1: 14)

Our Lady goes to the upper room in Jerusalem, the place of the Eucharist and with the Apostles prays from the heart. Mary, is doing this once more in Medjugorje, she is the Mother of the Church, and is guiding the Church in these times.

Let us pray,

*Lord Jesus,  
Create in me a deep love for the  
central message of your Gospel.  
A love for your Cross and  
Resurrection.*

*May it burn in my heart, fill my mind,  
and light up my path, so that I may be  
your Apostle of Love today.”*



**Medjugorje, April 15, 2019**

**Dear children of Medjugorje,  
 praise be to Jesus and Mary!**

**1. On April 2nd, 2019,** Mirjana received her monthly apparition at the Blue Cross, surrounded by a large group of pilgrims. After the apparition, she conveyed her message: ( see page 4 )

**2. The Eye of the Needle?** We are entering Holy Week and we desire to live it intimately with Jesus. We want to draw closer to Him more than ever! But how can we do this so that we are at one with Him at the time of the Resurrection? Saint John of the Cross explains, it is difficult to climb a high mountain if you are loaded with heavy burdens. As St. Paul explained before him, it is difficult for a running champion to win the trophy if he is cluttered with heavy equipment. But Jesus tells us clearly in the Gospel: "It is easier for a camel to pass through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the Kingdom of God." (Matt. 19:24).



In order to properly interpret these words of Christ, we have to look back at His time. His audience knew what the eye of the needle meant. In Jerusalem, there was a door that was especially narrow. That was the door through which camels entered the city, but they first had to be rid of the heavy loads that they carried in large baskets hanging to their left and to their right. For the camel driver, the rule of the game was to leave the loads at the entrance to the city, where they were stored for further use. This door was so narrow that camels could under no circumstance get through it with their loads. They had to be slender. However, this door was known to the Jews of the time as the "eye of the needle", because of how narrow it was.

When Jesus gave this teaching, everyone could understand that no-one can enter the Holy City, a symbol here of the Kingdom of God, without first renouncing all their sins and possessions, everything that clutters a person and prevents them from entering through the narrow door, through this fearsome and salutary eye of the needle.

Today, the world is telling us just the opposite. You have to accumulate goods, and store up money at any cost. We want to become richer and more secure by acquiring earthly goods, sometimes even totally useless, but recommended - even imposed - by fashion and the society


of consumerism. This leads to so much dependency and even creates addictions and slavery to shopping, gambling etc! The world wants us to believe that the door that leads to salvation is wide, so why bother to live according to God's commandments since God is good and everyone will go to heaven!? This is a subtle lie of the perfect false mercy! Satan is very good at distorting the Word of God and making it say the opposite of what it means.

Last March 2nd, the Blessed Mother asked us to examine ourselves: "Dear children, I invite you to examine yourselves starting from my Son, to look to Him with your heart, and to see where you are and where your life is going." Where do I stand with Jesus? Am I able to go through the eye of the needle? Are my baskets loaded with major obstacles and preventing me from joining my beloved Savior who is calling me so ardently?

When Jesus spoke to the crowds and healed the sick, multiplied the loaves and cast out impure spirits, I was there with Him. When He walked on the waters, calmed the storm and miraculously caused the disciples to catch many fish, I was there with Him. But later, when He was sweating blood because of my sins, when He let Himself be arrested, bound, condemned unfairly and led to the cross of torment, where had I disappeared to? What superfluous riches, internal and external, prevented me from following Him to the end, at the time when He was alone in the hands of his

executioners? Where was I when no one defended Him while He poured out his blood to save me?

Dear brothers and sisters, may this Holy Week prompt us to review our lives, and to work on shedding whatever will not pass through the door of Heaven, which remains narrow. May the loving contemplation of the passion of Christ melt away our heavy loads, free us and allow us to happily celebrate His resurrection with a liberated heart!



**3. I have recently returned from 4 beautiful missions**, in Italy, Germany, Austria and Poland, taking advantage of the quiet season to leave Medjugorje. Thank you to all those who prayed and are still praying for these missions. I am amazed and so grateful to hear many testimonies. People have shared with me that they prayed a Novena of extra Holy hours, or did a special fast, a special Rosary, a night watch or other sacrifices so that these missionary journeys would bear lasting fruit in the hearts of people. I also felt the great love of the Gospa, who opened unexpected doors for our words to be spoken in churches and other places. But there

are too few of us who are testifying! So please pray to our Heavenly Father, as Jesus asks us to, to send more laborers for His harvest! Today more than ever, given the distress of our world, "the harvest is abundant and the laborers too few"!

**4. Several of my talks given during these missions** are already available on You tube, in Italian, English, French, German and Polish.

**5. Before celebrating the resurrection of Christ on Easter Sunday,** let us not forget the wonderful Novena to Divine Mercy, which Jesus himself dictated to St. Faustina. It will begin on Good Friday, 19 April and end on Sunday the 28th, on the feast of Divine Mercy.


Here are His words:

"My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or of angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. Everything that exists has come forth from the very depths of My most tender

mercy. Every soul in its relation to Me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity. The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy." *The Diary of St Faustina*, § 699.

"Jesus is commanding me to make a novena before the Feast of Mercy, and today I am to begin it for the conversion of the whole world and for the recognition of The Divine Mercy.... so that every soul will praise My goodness. I desire trust from My creatures. Encourage souls to place great trust in My fathomless mercy. Let the weak, sinful souls have no fear to approach Me, for even if it had more sins that there are grains of sand in the world, all would be drowned in the unmeasurable depths of My mercy." *The Diary of St Faustina*, §1059.

The plenary indulgence promised by Jesus through this Novena which



accompanies it, is an exceptional grace given to our time which is exceptionally attacked by the Evil one. Let us grasp this grace and make it known throughout the world! So many afflicted souls are desperately

waiting for such good news to be able to raise from the darkness!

**Dearest Gospa**, in these holy days, more than ever we grasp your motherly hand, so that we may follow you with love to your Son Jesus, as He is defeating our death and offering us His life! Please unite our hearts to your most Immaculate Heart, that we may adore Him with you and console Him!

### **Last minute... Oh Mary, Notre Dame de Paris!**

We are in tears! Your cathedral is burnt! It has fallen down in flames! This beautiful Sanctuary, which had been spared from all the bombings so far, is now destroyed from inside! The whole world could witness that catastrophe live! How many times did I go there to pray during my youth! I can only weep and pray that we, French people, may start rebuilding our inner cathedrals, in our own hearts, in the dwelling places of the living God! I pray that we may repent from our apostasy and remember Our Lord who has been so generous to us over the centuries, in signs, visitations and apparitions, and who gave us so many great saints!

## **Praying The Rosary**

(extract from the book 'My Heart Will Triumph' by Mirjana Soldo.)

A short prayer from the heart is more powerful than a long one comprised of words with no feeling. God speaks to us through love, so love is the language He understands. Having seen Our Lady over 700 times since 1981, I never get bored while praying the rosary because I can envision her every time I say a Hail Mary. Still, I remember being a little girl and feeling impatient whenever Grandma Jela led the evening prayers. It's not always easy to focus, but Our Lady says that nothing unites a family better than praying the rosary together. If your thoughts begin to wander when you are praying, then put the rosary aside and speak directly to Our Lady. as a child talks to his mother. Tell her why you can't be still. Tell her what's burdening you. Give her whatever you have in your heart and she will give you what's in hers – the peace of God.

After having to hide my faith from the communists, I still pray the rosary on my fingers. Even when I have a rosary, I usually end up giving it to someone I meet, and if I'm asked to lead the rosary in a group, I prefer to use my fingers because I'm afraid of miscounting the beads.



**The Easter Triduum  
Medjugorje**

During the Easter Triduum Archbishop Henryk Hoser led us to Jesus' Passion, Death and Glorious Resurrection. In his homily on Holy Thursday, he reminded us that Jesus on this day instituted the Eucharist as the memorial sacrifice of His death and resurrection, asking of His disciples to celebrate His death and resurrection to His second coming.

He said "Jesus ministered the first Communion and ordained them as priests", he added that the Communion in Latin (communio) means to be together, to live together and to love one another.

Msgr Hoser concelebrated with 48 Priests during the Easter Vigil.

In his homily he said:

"For two thousand years there is no better news than this one, Risen Jesus, Son of God, is looking for us where we are. He is not afraid to come close to us, to touch us in our depths and to take us up, to the fullness of life. This miracle takes place each day here in Medjugorje. We come back to the grace of our baptism and become able to spread the faith of the Church and to walk on the path of holiness and salvation", said Msgr. Hoser added that St. John Paul II, in the year 2000, introduced the first Sunday after the Easter as Divine Mercy Sunday, the greatest fruit of His Death and Resurrection'.

Archbishop Hoser wished everyone to live the joy of the Resurrection always and everywhere. "For true Christian, disciple of the Lord, there are no hopeless situations as the Christ is the centre of the universe and the history. He is the centre of our existence and our life", said Msgr. Henryk Hoser.

**Currency** - Convertible MARK is the local currency, which cannot be purchased here. The Euro is the most popular currency used and accepted. Some shops and restaurants accept Credit Cards.  
 There are banks and exchange offices in Medjugorje where traveller's cheques can be changed.

As you will be doing quite an amount of walking (to Apparition Hill – Podbrdo and Cross Mountain – Mt Krizevac) we would recommend you take a strong comfortable pair of shoes /trainers.

The weather can be unpredictable, please ensure you have some clothing to keep you warm and dry. The average temperature in Medjugorje will be approx. 17-25 degrees centigrade (63-77 Fahrenheit) Sun hat and sun lotions are recommended.

**Batteries** - Remember to pack these in your hand luggage. A torch would be very useful in the evenings for walking through the fields and climbing Podbrodo. Torches can be purchased very cheaply in the local shops.

**Gratuities** - It is customary for voluntary collections to be taken at the end of our pilgrimage for: a) The House/ Hotel. b) The guide.

### **Month of May & October—Dedicated to Our Lady**

May and October are months traditionally dedicated to honouring Our Lady—May as “Mary’s Month” and October as a month of the Rosary  
This October (24-26), we will have the joy of welcoming the statue of Our Lady of Walsingham to the Diocese of Hexham and Newcastle. This is a stage in the statue’s two year “Dowry Tour” which is part of the spiritual preparation for the rededication of England as the Dowry of Mary in 2020. This title of England as the ‘Dowry of Mary’ has a very long history—possibly from even before the Norman Conquest— and reminds us of the great devotion to Our Lady that flourished here throughout the Middle Ages.

In our own Diocese, we have a shrine to Our Lady of Jesmond. Pilgrim Street, in the centre of Newcastle is said to have derived its name from the pilgrims who lodged there on their way to Our Lady’s chapel at Jesmond. Its name (in Latin) can also be found In the copy of a grant of a house made to Brinkburn Priory, Northumberland in 1292.

The 2020 re-dedication is the latest in a long series of dedications over the centuries. It is seen as the people of England offering their personal gift of faith to the Mother of God, asking her to guide and protect the country in the years to come.

## The Feast of Our Lady of Fatima 13<sup>th</sup> May 2019

Medjugorje is a continuation of Fatima.

*"I desire to realise the secrets I began in Fatima may be fulfilled"*  
(Medjugorje message 25 Aug 91)

In Fatima Our Blessed Mother appeared to three simple shepherd children six times in 1917 so they could warn the world of upcoming trials and tribulations. The three children were, siblings Jacinta, age 7, and Francisco Marto, age 9, and their cousin Lucia Dos Santos, age 10. Since that time, many of the prophecies have come true, and there is much debate about the happenings involving the Third Secret and Our Lady's request to consecrate Russia to Her Immaculate Heart.

**At Fatima Our Lady asked for consecration to her Immaculate Heart.**

Living that consecration means becoming an apostle of Mary, striving to imitate her virtues. To everyone who makes that consecration and sincerely tries to live it, the words of Our Lady to the child Lucia at Fatima would also apply:

*"I will never leave you; my Immaculate Heart will be your refuge, and the way that will lead you to God."*
